Gallup says talents are natural patterns of thought, feeling, or behavior that can be productively applied. They are abilities that feel like second nature to you.





Complete understanding and the ability to perform accepted field-test procedures for all backflow prevention assemblies is required for successful completion.

The 8-hour, 1-day class provides a recertification opportunity to keep your certification current and up-to-date.






Versapay & 2025 Dues


Good afternoon,
